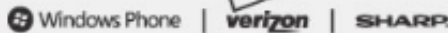
And looks are not everything - set the sounds that ring true to you! Just tap Settings > Sound and sample all the ringers and alerts until you find the ones that fit YOU.

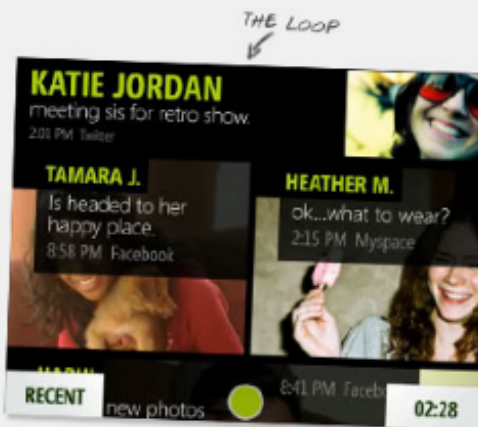

The first thing you see when you open your KIN phone is the KIN Loop. Just tell your KIN who and what's most important to you, and it delivers the latest updates from your favorite places. Sound simple? Of course it is.

NEWS, EVENTS, WEBSITES, SOCIAL NETWORKS ... YOU GET THE DRIFT.

You can add your favorite websites and social networks to your Loop to get frequent updates from the feeds you've tagged as favorites. Anytime you want to get the full scoop, just tap the item in your Loop. If it's a news item, it'll open in your Feed Reader. From there, you can tap Open in browser to see the full story.

I'M THINKING OF YOU 'CAUSE YOU'RE MY FAVORITE.

Put your best friends first by elevating them to your Favorites. To make someone a favorite, go to the Favorites screen, tap an empty box, then tap the person you want to add as a favorite.

You can have up to 50 favorites on your KIN. They'll appear on your home screen, and their status updates, posts, and photo shares will be sent to the top of your KIN Loop - so you'll always see them first as they come in. If you tap on a friend's post, you can comment on it.

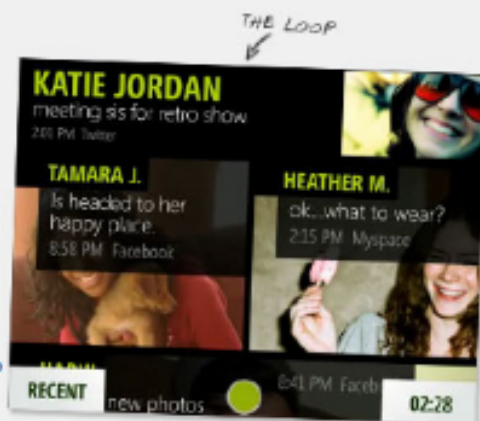

DROP IT IN THE SPOT.

KIN Features: Lesson 2 (just 1 left!)

See that circle at the bottom of your phone's screen? That's the KIN Spot, where you'll put all the things you want to share. Think "attachments" - only easier and better.

Drag and drop almost anything - photos, status updates, webpages - into the KIN Spot, then choose who to send to and how to send it - text, email, social network update. Then KIN does it for you. Just like that.

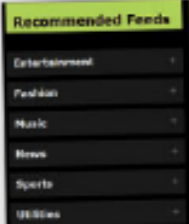
TOUCH THE BROWSER TO PAN AND ZOOM.

SURFING THE WEB WITH THE KIN BROWSER.

It's easy to go to any website on your KIN. Just go to Apps > Browser, type in the web address, then tap the arrow to the right of the address or press Enter to open the webpage.

Need to get a close up - or panned back - view of a website? There are two easy ways to do it: pinch in/out with your thumb and forefinger, or double-tap to zoom in and double-tap again to zoom out.

Your phone makes it easy to follow different blogs and websites all in one place - the Loop. Browse to your favorite mobile websites and you can add any RSS feed to the Feed Reader. It'll be tagged as a favorite and updated stories will show up in your Loop.

You can find some great feeds on KIN.com to keep up on fashion, music, news and sports. Check them out using your PC [here](#), or subscribe directly from your phone. Go to the Feed Reader, then click on Add and you'll see the list. Click on your favorite sites to add the feed.

To share interesting websites, updates and news stories with friends, just tap and drag them from your Loop into the KIN Spot.

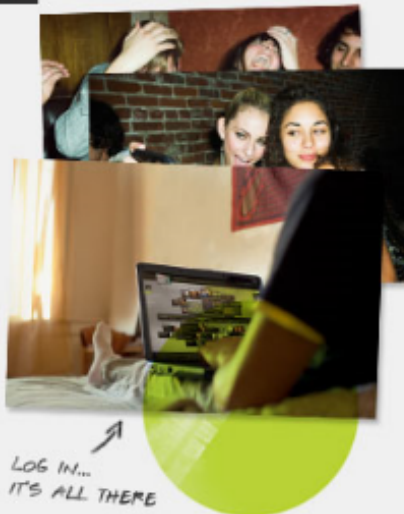
KIN Features: Lesson 3 (last one!)

Everything you create on your KIN gets automatically backed up to the Studio. Say you forget your phone and need a friend's number, or you want to show off your photos on a larger screen. You can do it on any computer. Surf to [KIN.com](#) and sign in with the account info you used when you set up your phone. It's all there - anytime, anywhere.

- Almost everything you create with KIN - **messages, contacts, photos, videos** - gets backed up automatically to your own personal website.

- **Bottomless photos:** You can take as many **photos and videos** as you like on your KIN. Since everything is automatically synced to the Studio, you don't have to worry about whether you have enough space for your pics on your phone.

- View your **feeds, call logs, text messages** and more in the Studio.

MUSIC AND MORE – YOU'VE GOT ZUNE® ON YOUR KIN.

You no doubt have great music, videos, and photos on your computer - now you can have them on your KIN too. First, download the Zune software onto your computer at www.zune.net/setup. Connect your KIN to the computer using the USB cable that came with your phone. Follow the prompts to complete set-up, then sync automatically or drag and drop your favorite songs, videos, and photos onto your KIN.

KIN users also get a free 14-day trial of Zune Pass, which lets you download and stream unlimited music. Go to your Apps screen > Music & More, then tap Zune Pass catalog.
